Priority is given to WWII Veterans and Veterans who are terminally ill, but we accept applications for Veterans of all service eras.

Our typical itinerary is noted below, but is always subject to change based on weather and final travel logistics per trip:

Day One: travel day from DIA to BWI. Get settled into hotel, rest, and dinner.

Day Two: Bus ride into Washington with stops at WWII Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Vietnam War Memorial, the "Lone Sailor" Navy Memorial, and the Washington Navy Yard Museum. Bus ride back to hotel and dinner banquet.

Day Three: Bus ride to Arlington National Cemetery to witness the changing of the guard at the Tomb of the Unknowns, Air Force Memorial, Marine Corps Memorial, FDR Memorial, and MLK Memorial. Bus ride back to BWI for flight home.
